

On the Job Training Initiative For Employers

Are you an employer in need of qualified employees?

The Elizabeth Development Company (EDC) **On-the-Job-Training** Initiative is designed to help employers find qualified Union County residents to fills jobs. Specifically, the EDC helps employers establish or expand their on-the-job-training program, find Union County residents to fill those positions and navigate the process for employers to recieve tax incentives, reimbursements, or other qualifying benefits.

What incentives are there for hiring On-the-Job-Training participants?

Wage Subsidy

You will receive up to half of your new employees' gross wages for up to 26 weeks to help defray the costs of their employment training.

Tax credit

You may be eligible for a Work Opportunity Tax Credit — up to \$5,000 over 2 years.

Apprenticeship subsidy

You may use this program to help fund the first 6 months of an apprenticeship program for qualified participants.

How can I find qualified participants looking for work?

- Employers provide the EDC with job specifications and/or job orders
- The EDC employment specialists, along with its initiative partners, prescreen qualified candidates
- Employers interview and select the right employee for the position and provide training
